

PRE-NURSING

Preparing for Lakeview College of Nursing

Eastern Illinois University has a cooperative agreement with Lakeview College of Nursing. After completing 2 years at Eastern Illinois University, the student would then apply to Lakeview College of Nursing to complete the coursework necessary to satisfy a Baccalaureate in Nursing (BSN). When enrolled at Lakeview, the student will pay Lakeview tuition and fees; however, they may live on the EIU campus and use all of the campus services. Lakeview College of Nursing requires a minimum 2.50/4.00 prerequisite GPA to be considered for admission. Note that a 2.50 GPA is the **minimum** accepted.

However, due to the competition, it typically takes a higher GPA to gain admission.

☐ **Current CPR Certification.** Verification of current certification in CPR is a prerequisite for enrollment in all clinical courses. The only two courses accepted are The American Heart Association – Basic Life Support (CPR and AED Program) – OR – The American Red Cross – Basic Life Support for Health Care Providers. Ideally this should be taken as close to the Lakeview start date as possible. This certification is offered at Sarah Bush Lincoln Health Center the first Tuesday of every month, but you need to sign up with SBLH prior to attending.

☐ All courses must be completed with a grade of "C" or above. Completion of a minimum of 60 credit hours of general education and prerequisite courses and 60 credit hours in nursing, totaling 120 semester hours in accordance with the curriculum plan, is required in order to earn Lakeview's BSN Degree.
