At Eastern, psychology is treated as a natural science, a social and behavioral science, and a profession. The undergraduate curriculum in the Department of Psychology is designed to prepare students for graduate studies, careers, and lifelong learning. At the core of the curriculum is a set of carefully selected required courses that enable students to master basic psychological principles, theories, scientific methods, and application. Students fulfill their departmental graduation requirements by taking the required core courses, choosing courses within several content areas, and taking other electives.

# **MAJOR IN PSYCHOLOGY: 36-39 HRS**

A grade of C or better is required in all psychology courses counting toward the major. All PSY courses have PSY 1879G (Intro Psych) as a prerequisite in addition to any others listed. All PSY courses are 3 credits, unless otherwise noted.
