1. Completion of MAT 1271 or higher-level math course with a grade of C or better; or ACT math score of 26 or higher or SAT math score of 610 or higher.

[Note: MAT 1271 does not fulfill EIU's general education mathematics requirement. MAT 2250G fulfills the mathematics requirement for the psychology major and the general education mathematics requirement.]

2. Completion of PSY 1879G (or equivalent) with a grade of C or better.

Major in Psychology (36-39 total credit hours)

- A grade of C or better is required in all psychology courses counting toward the major.
- All PSY courses have PSY 1879G (Intro Psych) as a prerequisite in addition to any others listed. Please check the catalog for all course prerequisites.
- All PSY courses are 3 credits, unless otherwise noted.
