
#### Campus Climate Survey Results, Students (2022)

Part of the Quality Initiative to increase the diversity of faculty and staff for student success


The Campus Climate Survey was available to all students from September 8 through September 30. Three email invitations sent from the President's office invited all faculty and staff to complete the survey during this period. Of the 925 survey entries, 48 were identified by Qualtrics as spam and removed, 57 participants did not complete any questions, 348 completed some portion of the survey, and 472 completed the entire survey, resulting in 820 partial or complete responses, which is a response rate of approximately 12.6%. Participants could choose not to respond to any question. Results shown for each question include data from everyone who responded to the corresponding question.

#### Q2 1 - Overall, I am satisfied with my experiences at EIU.






#### Q5\_1 - Instructors appear to treat female students fairly.


Q5\_2 - Instructors appear to treat students with disabilities fairly.


Q5 3 - Instructors appear to treat White male students fairly.


Q5\_4 - Instructors appear to treat Students of Color fairly.






#### Q5\_5 - Instructors appear to treat veteran students fairly.




Q6\_2 - Instructors include perspectives representing various cultural, racial, or gender points of view in class discussions or writing assignments.






Q6\_3 - It is important to me that my instructors include these types of perspectives in the classroom.


Q6\_4 - It is important to my classroom experiences that some of my instructors be members of underrepresented groups (for example, racial minorities, members of the LGBTQ+ community).






Q6\_5 - I know where to go to report concerns of unfair treatment in the classroom.






#### Q6\_6 - I know where to go to report concerns of unfair treatment outside the classroom.


# Q7\_1 - Students from underrepresented groups encourage students who are not part of their group to participate in their programs and activities.


# Q7\_2 - Students from underrepresented groups take an active role in helping other students from underrepresented groups adjust to campus life.


### Q7\_3 - White students encourage Students of Color to join them in programs and activities.






### Q7\_4 - Students from different races need to socialize more with each other.




## Q8\_1 - I believe most students are comfortable interacting with students whom they perceive to have disabilities.


# Q8\_2 - I believe most students are comfortable interacting with students whom they perceive to have a different sexual orientation.


### Q8\_3 - I socialize with students who openly share a sexual orientation different from my own.




#### Q8\_4 - I have witnessed bad conduct toward other EIU students due to their sexual orientation

#### Q10 - The racial/ethnic climate at EIU is tense.




#### Q11 - Which of the following is contributing the most to the tense climate? - Selected Choice


#### Q12 - The racial/ethnic climate at EIU is friendly.




## Q13 - Students tend to support events/programs consistent with their racial identity.




#### Q14 - How concerned are you about this racial/ethnic social-separation? 342 Responses




### Q15 - The university faculty/staff can affect whether students of different races/cultures choose to interact socially with each other.






# Q17 - Since attending EIU, how have your feelings changed toward people of other races?








Q18\_2 - Students have the responsibility to conduct themselves in a way that contributes to a positive campus climate for LGBTQ+ students.


#### Q19\_1 - I believe that microaggression exists on EIU's campus.





Q19\_2 - I have been a victim of microaggression from my peers.


Q19\_3 - I have been a victim of microaggression from a faculty/staff.






# Q19\_4 - I have witnessed microaggression against a student by a faculty/staff.







#### Q19\_5 - I have witnessed microaggression against a student by another student.



## Q20\_1 - EIU has an obligation to promote and encourage positive racial interactions on campus.




# Q20\_2 - EIU provides opportunities to attend programming of various types that recognize different cultural or racial issues.




# Q20\_3 - EIU provides opportunities to attend programming of various types that recognize different sexual orientations.




Q20\_4 - EIU provides opportunities to attend programming of various types that recognize different disability issues.








#### Q20\_7 - EIU appears to be accommodating in the classroom to students with disabilities.





### Q21 - EIU appears to be supportive of the needs of students who are veterans.




















### Q37 - Do you have a disability that presents challenges in the classroom or on campus?






