REQUIREMENTS

Candidates should have an Associate of Arts degree, or close, with general education courses that can be transferred to EIU.

DEGREE FORMAT

The program takes 3 years to complete and is offered in a hybrid/online format during nights and weekends, perfect for currently working professionals.

FINANCIAL AID

An Illinois Board of Higher Education Grant allows the Department of Special Education to offer a limited number of forgivable student loans up to \$25,000 for tuition and fees.
