Departmental Honors students have priority, but University Honors or EIU General Honors students may request seats through Ms. Schmidt.

MUS 3595 will be jointly taught with a section of MUS 3585 scheduled with the same faculty member for the same days and time. If MUS 3595 is full, when you register for classes, please instead enroll in the jointly taught section of MUS 3585. On request, Ms. Schmidt can ask that your seat be changed to MUS 3595.
