COMMUNITY HEALTH OPTION

Health Educators and Community Health Workers help their clients learn how to live a healthier life. Using data collected about specific health concerns and populations, Community Health Educators design and implement strategies to improve the health of individuals and communities.

Community Health is an ideal option for students who want to work with individuals and communities to find ways to improve people's health status. Students are trained to evaluate and assess both individual and community health issues by examining risk factors, protective factors, available resources, community support for change, and characteristics of vulnerable populations. Students build on these analytical skills by developing program plans including assessment and evaluation components. Students in this option are eligible to sit for the Certified Health Education Specialist exam in their last term of study.
