Financial Aid

We currently have a grant from the Illinois Board of Higher Education (Grow Your Own) that allows us to offer a limited number of forgivable loans up to \$25,000 for tuition and fees (does not cover all costs). These loans are forgiven if you complete the program and teach in a hard to staff school in Illinois for five years.
