- Fashion Merchandising was able to host their Biennial Fashion Show (in-person) in the Doudna concourse in Spring 2022.





CHEMISTRY AND BIOCHEMISTRY

Programs: B.S. in Chemistry, Biochemistry or Chemistry Management

B.A. in Chemistry, B.S. in Science with Teacher Licensure (Chemistry)

Ability to major and pursue pre-health option

Accelerated BS/MS and BA/MS (5-year program)

Departmental Honors (write thesis on research, take graduate course)

Minor in Chemistry or Biochemistry (2 or 3 courses beyond gen chem & org, with labs)







Major requirements (typically freshman & sophomore classes):

year-long gen chem with labs (not a gen-org-biochem course) year-long organic chem with lab our organic II is a continuation of org I, not org I with more detail

Requirements outside major:

Calc I and Calc II

Physics I and Physics II with labs
Calc based preferred, but non-calc base accepted
Is best if these are done BEFORE junior year
(so can take physical chem courses (CHM 3910 & 3920))

Special features EIU Chem / Biochem programs:

Student seminar series – majors give two PowerPoint seminars (including Q&A) to peers and faculty

Student research – have 13 undergrad working in 4 different groups at moment

Student presentation/internship – students present at National ACS meetings, regional meetings student had a summer internship at Argonne Natl Lab Research grants – 4 successful for FY22, over \$250K

- Major Goals for the Year

- Plans to reassess (and likely remove) many course prerequisites
- Revise the Graduate Program which is currently on a two-year hiatus

English

- We've made a few changes to our curriculum for English majors to help ensure timely graduation, both for teacher certification students and for English majors in literary studies, creative writing, or professional writing.
