



HONORS PROGRAM IN HEALTH PROMOTION

The Department Honors Program in Health Promotion offers an advanced specialization within the Department of Health Promotion. The program includes courses with honors level expectations, research, independent study and thesis options which allow students to customize their experience by following areas of personal interest through more intense and comprehensive exploration.

PROGRAM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

There are two ways to be admitted to the Health Promotion Honors Program:

OVERALL GPA PATHWAY

- 12 s.h. completed at EIU with cumulative GPA of 3.5
- Permission of Departmental Honors Program Coordinator and Dean of Pine Honors College

OR

MAJOR GPA PATHWAY

- 12 s.h. completed at EIU including 9 s.h. HPR/HCM courses
- Major GPA of 3.75 or higher
- Permission of Health Promotion Departmental Honors Program Coordinator and Dean of Pine Honors College

PROGRAM PLAN OF STUDY:

Honors students meet with the Department Honors Coordinator and their undergraduate academic advisor every semester to select courses and refine their plan of study.

REQUIRED COURSES:

- **HPR 4555** Health Promotion Honors Research. Credits: 3 [*replaces HST 3800*]
- **HPR 4644** Health Promotion Honors Thesis/Capstone. Credits: 3

ELECTIVE COURSES (SELECT 6 SEMESTER HOURS):

- Graduate level Health Promotion course. Credits: 3
- Study Abroad. Credits: 3+
- **HPR 4444** Health Promotion Honors Independent Study. Credits: 3
- University Honors course. Credits: 3
- Internship. Credits: 3 [*Supplemental to internship required for the HPR, HA, HCM program*]

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
