This award is **not** based on financial need and requires completing a simple 1 page application.

<u>ISAC gives 250 awards annually.</u>* (A) maximum of 40 awards to qualified applicants who hold a valid teaching certificate in some other disciple; (B) maximum of 105 awards to qualified applicants who have graduated from an approved high school prior to the academic year in which award is made; (C) minimum of 105 awards to qualified applicants who are scheduled to graduate from an approved high school in academic year the award is made <u>and</u> who perform in upper half of their class based on data provided by the high school at the end of the sixth semester. Recipients from this group selected based on the highest ACT or SAT test scores from appropriate time period.

> If more than the specified numbers of applicants qualify, a LOTTERY is used to select the recipients.

[General Educational Development (GED) Certificate recipients are not eligible for this waiver.]
