REQUIREMENTS

The Mathematics for Teacher Licensure major requires 50 credit hours in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science.

Courses consist of:

- Calculus
- Geometry
- Probability and Statistics
- Computer Science
- Technology in Mathematics
- Abstract Algebra
- Linear Algebra
- History of Mathematics
- Mathematics Education

Additional coursework is required for General Education (approx. 40 credit hours) and by the College of Education and Professional Studies. These credits include a number of specialized education courses, as well as a full semester of student teaching.

Additional requirements

- Overall GPA of 2.75 and a major GPA of 2.75 are both needed in order to be cleared for student teaching
- A grade of 'C' or better is needed in all coursework.
