+ 24 OR MORE SEMESTER HOURS:

2.0/4.0 overall; AND 2.0/4.0 from last college attended, OR

+ FEWER THAN 24 SEMESTER HOURS:

2.0/4.0 overall; AND 2.0/4.0 from last college attended; AND meet the following high school admission criteria:

TEST-REPORTED

2.5/4.0 GPA and 18 ACT or 960 SAT*

TEST-OPTIONAL

2.8/4.0 GPA

*SAT 860 if taken prior to March 2016
