

# EIU TRANSFER STUDENT CHECKLIST

We put together this guide to help you with your journey toward the first day of class. The information on this checklist and at [my.eiu.edu](http://my.eiu.edu) will help you stay on track during the days ahead. We're committed to your success, so let's do this together.

## 1. PLANNING

- Work with advisor at primary college on transfer curriculum.
- Work with your college's career services office prior to transferring.
- Work with EIU Transfer Relations for pre-transfer academic assessment.
- Create an account and register in MyEIU: [my.eiu.edu](http://my.eiu.edu)

## 2. VISIT US

- Visit Eastern and take a tour prior to enrollment. Transfer-specific campus tours are offered Friday at 9:00 a.m. General campus tours are offered Monday-Friday at 10 a.m and 2 p.m.
- Visit [admissions.eiu.edu](http://admissions.eiu.edu) or call the Office of Admissions at 217-581-2223 for additional information.
- Schedule an appointment to meet with a transfer counselor for an unofficial credit evaluation.
- Attend an Open House.

## 3. APPLY

- Apply early! We begin accepting applications one year prior to enrollment. For an online application, visit [eiu.edu/apply](http://eiu.edu/apply)
- Have final official high school transcript showing date of graduation and/or GED scores sent.
- Have official college transcripts sent from [each](#) college attended for admission decision.
- Have updated and final official college transcripts sent.

## TRANSFER ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS:

### 24+ SEMESTER HOURS

2.0/4.0 overall; AND 2.0/4.0 from last college attended,

**OR**

### FEWER THAN 24 SEMESTER HOURS

2.0/4.0 overall; AND 2.0/4.0 from last college attended,

**AND**

meet the following high school admission criteria:

**TEST-OPTIONAL: 2.8/4.0 GPA**

**OR**

**TEST-REPORTED: 2.5/4.0 GPA AND 960 SAT OR 18 ACT**

## 4. FINANCIAL AID & SCHOLARSHIPS

- Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), using last year's taxes, as soon as it is available at [studentaid.gov](http://studentaid.gov). (EIU FAFSA code: 001674)
- Eligible students can complete the Alternative Application as soon as it is available at [isac.org](http://isac.org)
- Apply and be admitted to EIU as early as possible to ensure maximum financial assistance.
- Mid-year transfers call 1-800-4-FED-AID.
- Transfer scholarships: [eiu.edu/scholarships](http://eiu.edu/scholarships)

## 5. HOUSING

- Once admitted, apply for on-campus housing through your MyEIU account: [my.eiu.edu](http://my.eiu.edu)
- If living off campus, begin housing search six to nine months prior to enrollment.

## 6. CAREER SERVICES

- Once admitted, contact Career Services at 217-581-2412 or [eiu.edu/careers](http://eiu.edu/careers) to get assistance with major selection, internship placement, job shadowing, resume writing, etc.
- Begin preparing for the upcoming EIU Job Fair prior to enrollment.

## 7. REGISTER

- Sign-up for an Orientation date through MyEIU.
- Select Intent to Enroll.
- Your Academic Advisor will contact you to schedule an appointment for advisement and registration.
- On-campus majors must attend orientation to connect with campus resources and have the opportunity to locate your classrooms.

- Return Immunization Form (available in MyEIU or at [eiu.edu/health/IMForm.pdf](http://eiu.edu/health/IMForm.pdf)) to EIU Health & Counseling Services Office.

## 8. YOU'RE HERE!

- Move in to residence hall or apartment one week before classes.
- Complete Alcohol EDU, sexual assault prevention and mental well being online resource requirements.
- Check your Panther Mail about Welcome Week events.
- Pick up textbooks at Textbook Rental Service before classes. Textbooks may be mailed to students enrolled in online and off-campus courses.
- Get involved and make connections through the many events and organizations on campus.
- Apply for graduation during your junior year to receive a degree audit that includes transfer credit, waivers, and remaining requirements for degree completion.
