RISE Academy

Rise Academy is a year-long program designed to kick off a students' freshman year at Chicago State University. RISE is a 5-week pre-term intensive program

- Designed for First-Time Freshmen and Transfer Students with less than 24 credit hours who have been admitted to CSU.
- **Scholarship**: *Rise* Scholars receive a full-tuition and fee scholarship for the academic year starting in the fall that's not covered by grants. Textbooks and the campus health care plan are included.
- **Personal laptop:** Chicago State will provide each student with a personal laptop to use during their undergraduate years. Internet access is also covered.
- Workshops/Programming: RISE Workshops, Career Awareness and Social Connection

Admissions Criteria

 Be an admitted student at Chicago State University

• Freshman:

- have a composite ACT score of 23 or higher,
- have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.5 or higher,
- graduate in the top 10% of their high school class
- Transfer Students with at least 12 credit hours
 - earn a minimum 3.35 cumulative
 GPA at CSU or an accredited
 transfer institution








Services We Offer

- Required immunizations for full compliance with the College Student Immunization Act [110 ILCS 20]
- Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD)/Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) screenings
- Women's Health Screenings
- Basic Physicals and Sports Physicals
- Minor Illnesses: Coughs, Colds, Nausea, Earaches,
 Sinus Infections, Fevers, Urinary Tract Infections
- Diagnostic Testing: Strep, Influenza (Flu)
- Minor Injuries: Abrasions, Sprains, Splinters, Steri-Strip Removal, Minor Burns
- Skin Conditions: Rashes, Bites
- Consultation/Education: High Blood Pressure, High Cholesterol, etc.

Immunization Requirements

- Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Meningococcal(Required for all college students 21 and younger) if first vaccine was given before the age of 16 a second dose must be given

Additional Requirements for programs

- Hepatitis B surface Antibody/ Antigen
- Varicella
- TB (Tuberculosis screening)
- Physical
