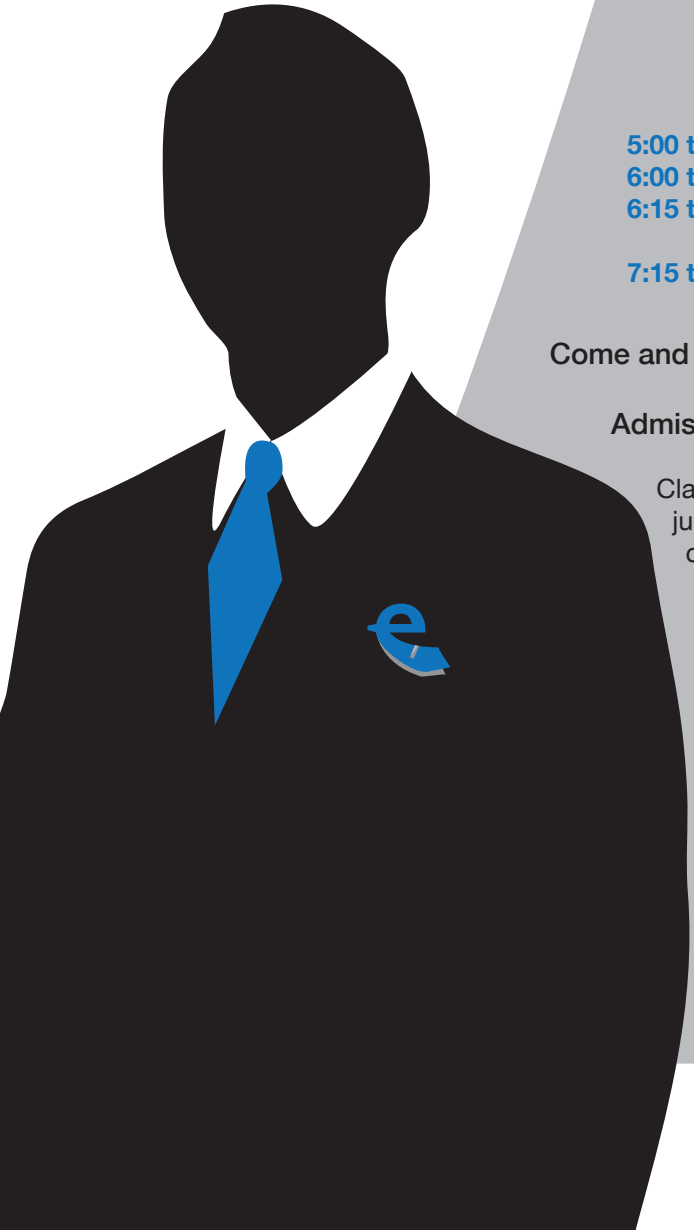
Come and see the businesses the Class E students have started!
